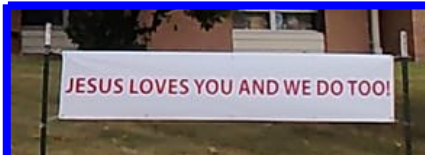

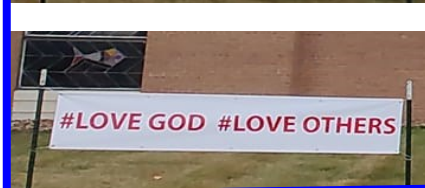

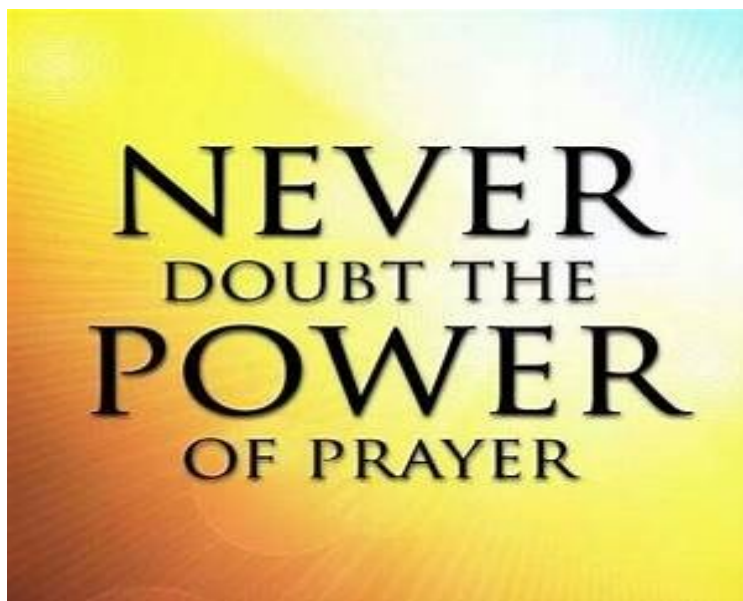

CWF Executive Committee met September 9.

Rummage Sale: Pat reported the sale made \$3,500.00. Manna House had school supplies in the Shelter House and were also priced "donation." Holiday items were held back from the Rummage Sale to be given to the youth for selling on November 9, 2024. The youth helped unload the stage on July 20, 2024, and volunteers got everything laid out on tables. Leftovers were picked up the next week by Big Brothers/Big Sisters.

Pie Making: The sale of pies is going quite well. The next pie-making day is September 20, 2024, at 9 am.

Festival of Sharing: Maryann reported items have been collected for the 25 Period Packs and 26 School Kits, 61 eye glasses and 277 best choice labels. Blessing of the items will be during the worship service on September 22nd. Pastor Tim will deliver them to Kansas City on September 28.

2025 Budget: With the exception of the \$200.00/quarter requested for snacks for the Tech School, there are no changes to the budget for 2025. This will be voted on at the Annual Meeting in November.

2025 Slate of Officers: Sharlotte Anderson and Carol Hinton have agreed to be co-presidents of the CWF executive committee for 2025. All other officers will remain the same.

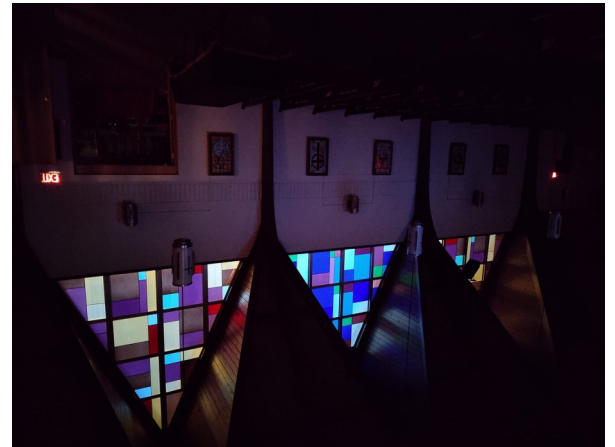
