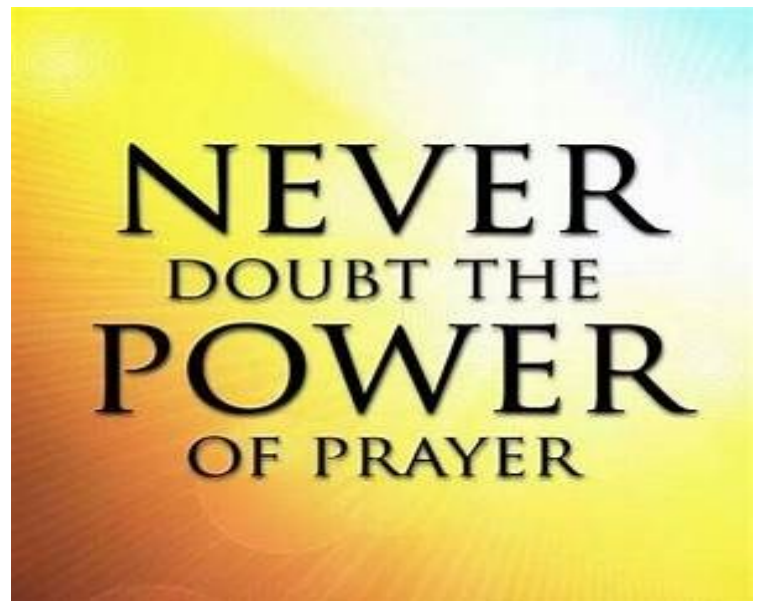

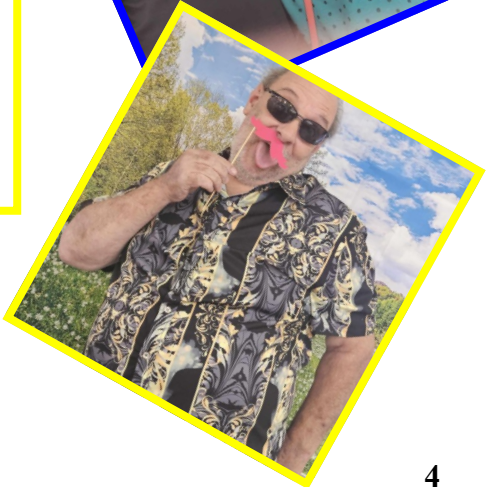

Parking Lot Resealing

It is time for our parking lot to be resealed, cracks filled, and parking spots restriped. To properly maintain asphalt, it needs to be resealed periodically, and it has been eight years since it was last sealed. The Property Committee obtained three bids, and it was decided to contract with D J Sealcoating and Striping, owned by David and Zeb Jordan, whose bid was \$9,700. This was approved by the Board at the August meeting. D J Sealcoating bids church parking lots at cost and asks the church to give a Love Offering above the cost amount. This is what they consider as "profit" for the job. The actual bid would have been \$14,700 if we were not a church. We ask that you prayerfully consider donating what you're comfortable with as a Love Offering as David and Zeb walk in faith that God will provide them with a profit. In summary, the church will pay \$9,700; any money collected for the Love Offering will be added to the bid amount. If you would like to contribute, please write "Parking Lot" in the memo line on your check or on the envelope if you are donating cash.

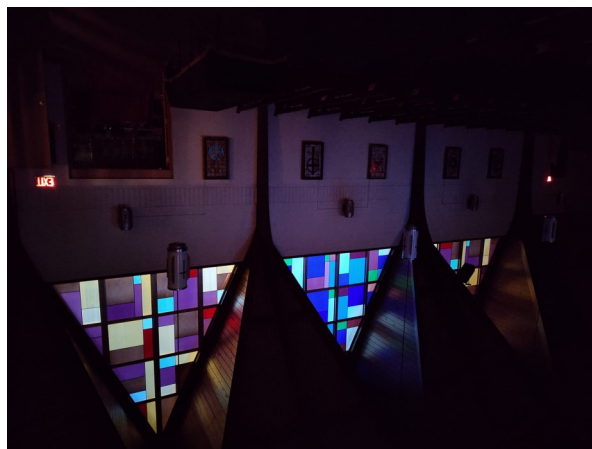
